

# 2015 SUNSHINE COAST ISLANDS' CLEANUP EVENT



## MATERIALS COLLECTED

**Maximum Load Size – 1 cubic meter per household** (i.e. size of 2 washing machines)

**Remove all batteries from items;** place any loose **nails/screws in a container.**

Household garbage **must** be placed in **CLEAR** plastic bags or it will **not** be accepted.

### Metal - 98% metal

- Appliances (e.g. stoves, washers, dryers, dishwashers)
- Misc scrap metal (e.g. lawn furniture, bed frames, pipes, misc metal)
- Fridges & freezers (e.g. contains Freon)
- Lawnmowers, trimmers, etc. - **must** have gas and oil removed
- Prawn and crab traps

### General Garbage

- Durable goods (e.g. stuffed chairs, sofas, mattresses, pink insulation)
- Misc. garbage
  - \*If bagged-**must** be in **clear** plastic bags
- Fish nets – **must be contained** in **clear** plastic bags. Loose fish nets not accepted.

### Glass – separate bin

- Pane glass - **must** be removed from frame, broken into pieces and placed in cardboard box

### Mixed Household Recyclables\* - not bagged

- Cardboard – cut into 1 metre x 1 metre pieces and tie together with twine
- Mixed paper
- Newspaper
- Tin/Aluminum Cans - *clean*
- Rigid plastic containers - *clean*
- Plastic shopping bags, bread and produce bags
- Glass containers (separate bin) – *lids off*
- Styrofoam food trays and cushion packaging - *clean*

### Paint Products\* - in original containers with original labels

- Must be leftover residential grade paint; paint containers up to 6 litres accepted

### Tires\* - passenger vehicle (P) to light truck (LT), no rims; dock tires with Styrofoam fill not accepted

- Max 4 per household; **tire pick up not guaranteed** if barge is full

### Household and Lead Acid (Car) Batteries\* - must not be leaking; tape all terminals prior to collection

Used Propane Tanks\* – must be empty; up to 20lb max (e.g. BBQ tank size)

## MATERIALS NOT COLLECTED

- Wooden furniture (e.g. bookcases, shelving, tables, dressers, chairs)
- Household hazardous waste (e.g. cleaners, pesticides, flammables, oily rags, gas, oil, fireworks)
- Batteries - boat
- Framed glass (e.g. windows, doors)
- Electronic waste (e.g. computers, TVs, screens, peripherals, audio/video)
- Construction and demolition waste (e.g. wood, shingles, gyproc, vinyl flooring, vermiculite insulation)
- Items longer than 12ft
- Boats – plastic or aluminum (e.g. canoes, kayaks, skiffs)
- Fish nets - loose
- Organics (e.g. kitchen waste, garden waste, land clearing debris)
