

## MIXED HOUSEHOLD RECYCLABLES





### **Products ACCEPTED** \*No sorting required, collected loose

#### **ALUMINIUM**

- Pop cans, tin foil, rigid trays, pie plates
  - > RINSE to remove food & grease

#### **BOXBOARD**

- Cereal, tissue & detergent boxes; paper egg cartons
  - > MUST be clean & unwaxed with any liners removed
  - > FLATTEN to optimize space

### **CARDBOARD**

- Corrugated boxes
  - > CUT into 1 X 1 metre pieces and TIE together with twine

#### **PAPFR**

 Newspaper & flyers, magazines, catalogues, telephone directories, books (remove cover from hard-cover books), junk mail, writing paper, computer paper, envelopes, paper gift wrap & cards (remove ribbons and bows), paper bags & rolls, tetra-packs, milk & juice cartons (rinsed), photos & negatives.

### **PLASTIC**

- Containers, jugs, lids, cold drink cups, plant pots, bottles, empty prescription containers
  - > RINSE to remove dirt, food & grease

### PLASTIC SHOPPING BAGS, BREAD AND PRODUCE BAGS

• BAG OF BAGS, bundle all bags into a plastic shopping bag

#### **STYROFOAM**

- Food trays/containers/cups, cushion foam for packaging (e.g. around computer)
  - > RINSE food trays/containers/cups to remove food and grease

#### TIN CANS

> RINSE, put loose lid in can, pinch closed

## **Products NOT ACCEPTED**

#### **FABRIC**

Clothing, textiles, cloth diapers

### **FOIL BAGS & WRAP**

Potato chip/candy/food bags, foil gift wrap

**FOOD & PET WASTE or any perishables** 

### **GLASS**

• Light bulbs, mirrors, pottery, dishes, broken glass

### PLASTIC

 Tarps, toys, tubes, caulking, motor oil containers, coolers, VHS or cassette tapes, take-out food containers

#### SOILED PRODUCTS

• Diapers, Q-tips, toilet paper

### **STYROFOAM**

- Peanuts, chips, noodles
- Foam insulation

SYRINGES or medical supplies of any kind

#### WAXED CARDBOARD

### OTHER

• Aerosol cans, wooden items, car parts

## **Products ACCEPTED** \*residential paint containers up to 6 litres

### INTERIOR/EXTERIOR HOUSEHOLD PAINT

• Latex, acrylic, water-based, alkyd, enamel, oil-based consumer paints

### MARINE PAINTS

• Unless registered under the Pest Control Act

MELAMINE, METAL & ANTI-RUST PAINTS, STAINS, SHELLACS

### **PRIMERS**

• metal, wood

### UNDERCOATS

### VARNISHES AND URETHANES

single component

### **Products NOT ACCEPTED**

\*UNIDENTIFIABLE OR UNLABELLED CONTAINERS

\*\*LEAKING CANS/CONTAINERS; IMPROPERLY SEALED CANS

### **AEROSOL PAINT**

Of any kind

**AUTOMOTIVE PAINT** 

BRUSHES, RAGS, ROLLERS

CAULKING COMPOUNDS, GLUES, EPOXIES

**CRAFT PAINT** 

#### INDUSTRIAL PAINT AND FINISHES

• e.g. based-on, heat resistant etc.

### PAINTS OR WOOD PRESERVATIVES REGISTERED AS A PESTICIDE

- under the Pest Control Act (has P.C.P. Reg# on label)
- E.g. marine anti-fouling paint

PAINT THINNERS, MINERAL SPIRITS OR SOLVENTS

**RESINS** 

STUCCO PAINT

TARS, TAR-BASED OR BITUMEN BASED PRODUCTS

### TWO-PART OR COMPONENT PAINTS

Containing catalyst or activator



## **BATTERY RECYCLING**



### NOTE:

- ALL BATTERY TERMINALS MUST BE COVERED WITH TAPE PRIOR TO COLLECTION
- REMOVE ALL BATTERIES FROM HOUSEHOLD ITEMS (e.g. flashlights)

### **Products ACCEPTED**

CAR (LEAD ACID) BATTERIES - all terminals must be taped

• Keep separate from household batteries

HOUSEHOLD BATTERIES – all terminals must be taped

- Nickel Cadmium (Ni-Ca)
  - Commonly found in cordless power tools, cordless phones, digital cameras, video cameras, two-way radios
- Lithium Ion (Li-Ion)
  - Commonly found in cell phones, cordless power tools, laptops, cordless phones, digital cameras, two-way radios
- Nickel Metal Hydride (NI-MH)
  - > Commonly found in cell phones, digital cameras, two-way radios
- Nickel Zinc (NI-ZN)
  - Commonly found in small electronics, wireless keyboards, digital cameras
- Alkaline/Single-Use Batteries
  - Commonly found in alarm clocks, flashlights, TV remote controls, calculators, remote control toys
- Lithium Primary Batteries
  - Commonly found in watches, pacemakers, hearing aids

# **TIRE RECYCLING**



### NOTE:

- CONDITIONALLY ACCEPTED BASED ON BARGE CAPACITY
- IF BARGE IS FULL THEN TIRES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED
- MAX 4 PASSENGER OR LIGHT TRUCK TIRES PER HOUSEHOLD
- MUST BE OFF-RIM

## **Products ACCEPTED**

### **PASSENGER TIRES**

- Code on sidewall of tire is (P)
- Must be off-rim
- Tires for cars, pick-up trucks, SUVs, vans, small RVs will be accepted for recycling

### LIGHT TRUCK TIRES

- Code on sidewall of tire is (LT)
- Must be off-rim
- For consumer vehicles under 10,000 lbs. Gross Vehicle Weight

**TIRES WITH RIMS** 

FOAM, CONCRETE OR OTHER FILLED DOCK TIRES

**COMMERCIAL AND MEDIUM TRUCK TIRES** 

• Any other tires not marked with P or LT

# **PROPANE TANKS**



# **NOTE:**

- MUST BE EMPTY
- HAVE VALVES OPEN TO DEMONSTRATE TANKS ARE EMPTY
- IF BARGE IS FULL THEN TANKS NOT ACCEPTED

### **Products ACCEPTED**

### **PROPANE TANKS**

- Must be empty
- Up to **20lb max** (e.g. size of a typical BBQ tank)
- Have valves open at collection to demonstrate your tank(s) are empty

# **Products NOT ACCEPTED**

PROPANE TANKS GREATER THAN 20lb

### DAMAGED TANKS

- That appear corrosive or to be leaking
- That appear damaged from a fire
- Are dented or damaged in any other way

OTHER PRESSURE TANKS

**OXYGEN TANKS**
