In case you are asked, we were unable to put in place a collection process for electronic waste this year. If people are interested, I can continue to explore how we can add this as a special item for next year.

Other materials that we are unable to accept this year but will need to be explored further are:

- Demolition and renovation materials (due to asbestos concerns and WorkSafeBC regulations)
- Dock/beach Styrofoam
